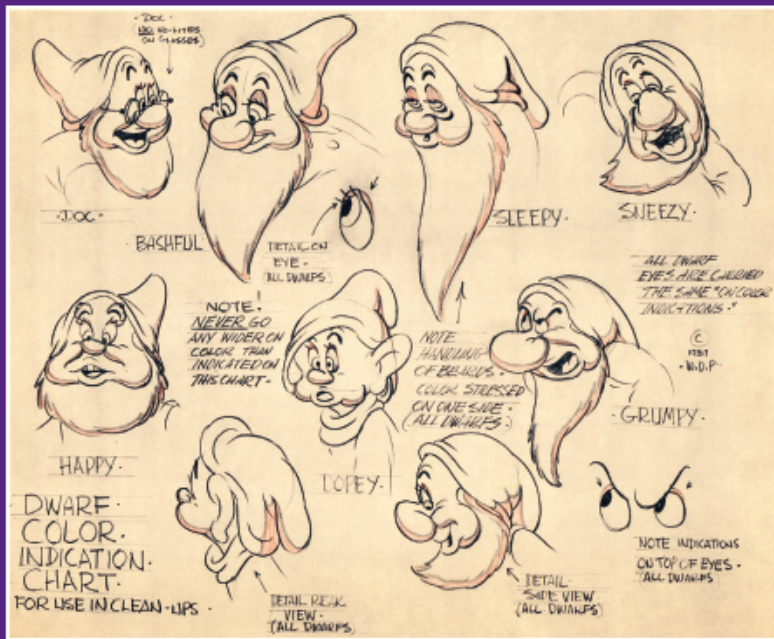
Snow White and the Seven Dwarfs: The Creation of a Classic celebrates the 75th anniversary of Walt Disney's pioneering feature-length animated film, a classic 1937 work that continues to be enjoyed by viewers of all ages. Offering a rare, behind-the-scenes glimpse into the making of the film, the exhibit features more than 200 original works of art—from conceptual drawings and early character studies to detailed story sketches and animation drawings, meticulously-rendered pencil and color layouts, rare watercolor backgrounds, colorful cels, and vintage movie posters.
